

# 2012 TEST DATES

## Special Scheduling applies to the following tests. See backlist pages 48–54 for individual book listings.

**CLEP** College Level Exam Program: Scheduled separately by region and given over a 5-day period once each month. The English Composition with Essay Exam will be given nationally only in January, April, June, and October. (p. 50)

**CPA** Certified Public Accountant Exam: Scheduled daily during the months of January, February, April, May, July, August, October, and November. (p. 50)

**COOP/HSPT/TACHS** Catholic High School Exam and High School Placement Test: Scheduled locally; the COOP is given during the month of November. (p. 50)

**DAT** Dental Admissions Test: Administered year-round at Prometric Test Centers in the United States, its territories including Guam, Puerto Rico, and the U.S. Virgin Islands, and Canada. (p. 50)

**GRE** Graduate Record Exam: Computer-Based Tests may be scheduled individually. Pencil & Paper testing is available in areas where the computerized test is not given. (p. 50)

**GMAT** Graduate Management Admission Test: Given daily depending on the availability at each location. (p. 50)

**HSPA** New Jersey High School Proficiency Assessment Tests: Math and Language Arts. Given in March and October. (p. 52)

**MCAT** Medical College Admission Test: AAMC offers 26 fully computerized MCAT administrations per year at hundreds of Thomson Prometric testing labs throughout North America. (p. 50)

**Mechanical Aptitude & Spatial Relations Test** Given by private employers and public agencies as needed. (p. 50)

**NJ ASK** New Jersey Assessment of Skills and Knowledge—Grades 3–8: Given in May. (p. 52)

**Nursing School Entrance Exam** Fall dates may differ by school. Check with the individual school. (p. 50)

**OCS** Officer Candidate School Test: Each branch of the military is different. Contact your local recruiter for more information and test dates. (p. 51)

**SHSAT** Specialized Science High Schools Admissions Test: Given in October and November in New York City. (p. 51)

**SOL** Virginia Standards of Learning—Algebra I: Given upon course completion. (p. 53)

**TOEFL** Test of English as a Foreign Language: Computer-Based Tests are now given about once a month, and scheduled locally. Supplemental paper-and-pencil tests are now given approximately every other month. (p. 53)
